



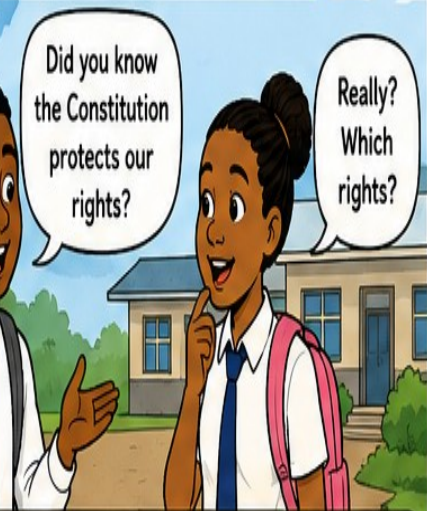

Chapter Four of the Constitution of Kenya contains the Bill of Rights.

RIGHT TO EDUCATION



Article 53:
Every child has the right to free and compulsory basic education.

FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION



Article 33:
Every person has the right to freedom of expression, including the freedom to seek, receive and impart information and ideas.

EQUALITY AND FREEDOM FROM DISCRIMINATION



Article 27:
All persons are equal before the law and have the right to equal protection and equal benefit of the law.

RIGHT TO HUMAN DIGNITY



Article 28:
Every person has inherent dignity and the right to have that dignity respected and protected.
